

## ***What is a “YIT”?***

***YIT*** is an acronym for a play on words, that better describes who I am, and who I am becoming, when compared to the arbitrary label assigned to this body at birth (Tom).

***Y*** stands for “Yzard,”

***I*** represents “in,” and

***T*** is for “training.”

Therefore, ***YIT*** is an acronym for “***Yzard-in-training.***”
